- Manage faculty and staff, to include recruitment and onboarding, performance evaluation, training and Effectively manage the financial and operational interests of the school, in keeping with the budgetary and strategic goals of the Board
- Oversee and execute all aspects of the admissions process, ensuring successful enrollment of families, in keeping with the school's commitment to growth, diversity and inclusivity

Requirements for this position include:

- Five or more years of teaching experience
- Fluency in English with excellent verbal and written communication skills
- Dedication to the Montessori method and philosophy
- Experience in a supervisory role
- Meet all necessary qualifications to work in the United States

Preferred qualifications for this position include:

- Master’s degree or higher in Education (or equivalent)
- Demonstrated leadership and decision-making in a Montessori or Independent School
- Administrator certification in Montessori education (AMI/AMS)
- Montessori teaching credentials for one level or more (early childhood and/or elementary)
